



OOPS, MY MISTAKE

This idea has been stolen from Richard Osman's House of Games on BBC TV. Below are fifteen incorrect statements: to correct them they each need one word changing. They are all based on Matthew's account [NIV] of the time around Jesus' crucifixion. Can you identify each wrong word and correct it?

1. On what we now know as Palm Sunday, Jesus told **two** disciples to go into the village and untie a donkey and its colt. [21:1]
2. During the following week, Jesus visited Simon's house in Bethany, where a woman poured perfume over His **head**. [26:7]
3. While Jesus was celebrating the Passover with His twelve disciples, He predicted that one of them would betray Him, saying "the one who has dipped his **hand** into the bowl with Me".
4. In the garden of Gethsemane a crowd from the chief priests, led by Judas Iscariot, arrived with the intention of **arresting** Jesus. [26:48-50]
5. Caiaphas the high priest questioned Jesus, and accused Him of blasphemy, while Peter **sat** with the guards in the courtyard. [26:57-58]
6. When Peter was confronted by a servant **girl** he denied knowing Jesus. [26:69-70]
7. After Jesus was arrested Judas returned the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests, who bought a field as a graveyard for **foreigners**. [27:5-7]
8. Before Pilate judged Jesus, his **wife** warned him against having anything to do with Jesus, who is innocent. [27:19]
9. Pilate washed **his** hands after declaring Jesus innocent of any crime deserving the death penalty. [27:24]
10. After Pilate released Barabbas, Jesus was taken to the Praetorium where the soldiers put a scarlet robe on Him, wove a crown of thorns for His head, and gave Him a **staff** to hold, before mocking Him and beating Him. [27:26-30]
11. The soldiers escorting Jesus to His crucifixion, forced Simon from **Cyrene**, to carry the cross for Him. [27:32]
12. On the cross Jesus cried out to God "Why have You forsaken Me?". Some of those who heard Him thought He was calling to **Elijah**. [27:46-47]
13. Joseph of Arimathea asked Pilate for the body of Jesus for burial. The **next** day the chief priests asked Pilate to secure the tomb so the disciples don't steal Jesus' body and claim He has risen from the dead. [27:62-66]
14. On the first day of the week, after the Sabbath, Mary and **Mary** arrived at the tomb where they were met by an angel who told them Jesus had risen from the dead. [28:1-6]
15. After Jesus' resurrection, the remaining disciples went to Galilee where they were met by the risen Jesus, who told them to make disciples of all **nations** and baptise them. [28:16-20]
